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Discover some of the best-kept secrets of the South Island by hiking and kayaking into the remote depths of the South Island. Come face to face with some of the worlds rarest species such as the yellow-eyed penguin, Hector dolphins and New Zealand's sea lions. Enjoy the mixture of camping or staying overnight in an alpine hut where evenings are spent creating fine meals while reliving the day's adventures.
